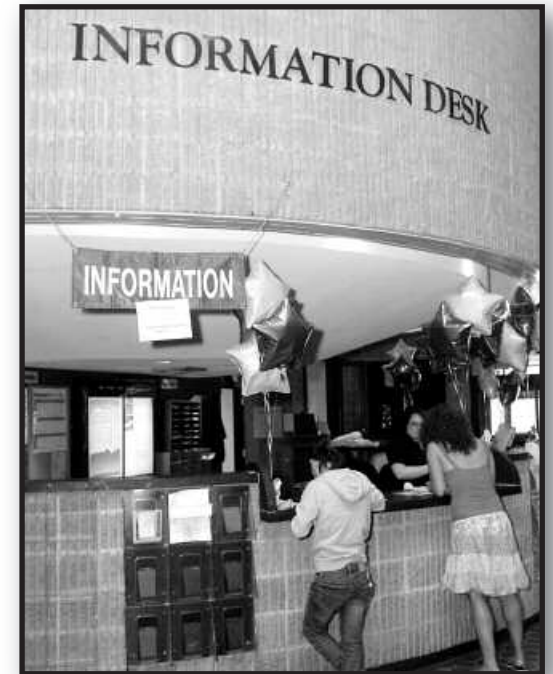

Center for Student Information

The Center for Student Information is a drop-in help desk located at the Hillwood Commons Information Desk to assist students in navigating My LIU — the new self-service student information portal available at <http://my.liu.edu>.

The Center's staff members can assist you with setting up your user account and password for My LIU. They can also help you understand the information contained on My LIU such as your class schedule, financial aid and bursar accounts, university e-mail, transcripts, grades, and tuition account holds for things like parking tickets or vaccination certification. The Center can help you resolve any questions you may have about your personal student records or can direct you to the appropriate offices or resources to resolve any problems or concerns.

The Center is open Monday – Thursday, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. and Friday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.



You can communicate with the Center for Student Information by logging into My LIU, and clicking the Help Button. You will be redirected to the Student Center Help Screens. Click on “Contact Us” and complete all information in the form.

My LIU is a secure network environment for all C.W. Post students. It is the gateway for students to access official University information and news.

My LIU Features

The My LIU (<http://my.liu.edu>) student information portal provides 24/7 online access to:

- E-mail
- Class schedules in daily and weekly format
- Your transfer credits record
- Your unofficial academic record (transcript)
- Information pertaining to your bill
- Financial assistance information
- Personal information including name, address, telephone numbers and e-mail addresses that are included in your student record
- Admissions status information
- Any holds (for unpaid bills, overdue books, parking tickets, etc.) on your record
- Checklist items (To Do Lists) of things that you may need to complete
- Important enrollment dates, financial aid Web sites and useful links
- Campus emergency notifications
- Official Campus and University news and announcements
