*****ALL UNDERGRADUATE REQUIREMENTS MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE A STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO CONTINUE PAST 6 CREDITS OF GRADUATE COURSEWORK: 24 additional Graduate level credits for M.S. required upon completion of B.S. portion. Must earn "B's" in grad classes.**

All students must be formally accepted into the accelerated program, incl. GMAT exam score, **prior** to registering for graduate courses.
