- LIS 514 Introduction to Research in Library & Information Center
(Prerequisite or Co-requisite LIS 510)
- LIS 690 Internship
(Prerequisites: LIS 510, 511, 512, 514, and most electives)

Electives Twenty-one credits* in LIS courses (seven courses) under faculty advisement
