

## **Plan of study for graduate students in Mathematics for Secondary School Teachers**

This plan of study is for all matriculated students in mathematics department who wish to pursue a degree in **Mathematics for Secondary School Teachers**. If you are “limited matriculated” please contact either Dr. Ahdout or Dr. Rothman to discuss your status.

**To sustain the matriculated status, student’s cumulative GPA may be no less than 3.00 and a student cannot have more than one grade lower than a “B” in mathematics courses that are applied toward the degree. This requirement can be satisfied by retaking a course if necessary. A student who earns three grades below “B” may lose his or her matriculated status or may be dismissed from the program.**

Every student in this program must complete **37 credits** of course work in the graduate program as follows:

### Required Courses (22 credits)

Math 511	Every spring
Math 512	Every other spring
Math 513	Every fall
Math 514	Every spring
Math 524	Every summer
Math 631	Every fall
Math 632	Every spring
Math 709	Every semester

### Elective Courses (15 credits)

A total of 15 credits, approved by the department are required.

After completing 30 credits, you should contact Dr. Ahdout to form your oral committee and register for Math 709. No oral exam will be scheduled during summers.
