## Degree Requirements for an MS in Art Education

- Complete, with an average of B or better, an approved program of 36 or 42 (see description below) credit hours including at least 18 hours in courses at the 600 and 700 level. Students are required to pass a comprehensive exam or final project or thesis.\*
- In addition, LAST and ATS-W examinations, Content Specialty Test, a 2-Hour Child Abuse Seminar, a Violence Prevention Seminar, and security fingerprinting are required for New York State Certification, All Grades.
- Evidence of 3/6 credits of foreign language is required for Certification.

## Transfer Credits

If pertinent to the applicant's plan of study, a maximum of 6 graduate credits with a grade of B or better may be transferred from another university's graduate program (12 credits from within Long Island University). The transfer will take place after the completion of 15 credits within this program but the request must be made at the time of the original application to the degree program and must be approved by the Graduate Advisor.
